The Buffalo City Council met in special session on Tuesday, February 15, 1994, at 6:01 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Phil Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Josie Collins, Tom Harland, Jr., David Kinsinger, Dick Nissen and Betty Walters. Absent, none. Purpose of the special meeting was to do contract negotiations.

The municipal workers union and the police union exchanged proposals with the council. The discipline procedure was added to the municipal workers contract. Motion by Walters and Collins to go into closed session to discuss the proposals per Iowa Code 20.17(3), negotiation of contracts. Voting yes were Collins, Harland, Kinsinger, Nissen and Walters. Motion carried. Council went into closed session at 6:11 p.m. All city employees went into another room and voted unanimously to accept the changes made and approve the two new three year contracts, effective 07/01/94. Open meeting resumed at 6:19 p.m. with all councilmembers present, and Mayor Hoover presiding.



Motion by Kinsinger and Harland to approve Resolution #15-94, "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE POLICE OFFICERS THREE YEAR CONTRACT." All members voted aye. Carried.

Community input was asked for. Ralph Jewett thanked the council, Mayor and everyone involved in negotiations for their time and consideration. Ken Bernauer asked if the Employees Handbook was going to be used with the contract and Mayor said it's part of the contract.

Motion by Walters and Kinsinger to adjourn the meeting at 6:25 p.m. All voted aye. Motion carried.
