The Buffalo City Council met in special session on Monday, March 14, 1994, at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Phil C. Hoover presiding, at City Hall. Present were Councilmembers Josie Collins, Tom Harland, Jr., David Kinsinger, Dick Nissen and Betty Walters. Absent, none. Purpose of the special meeting was to hold a public hearing on the fiscal 1994-1995 budget.

The Mayor announced the meeting open for public hearing on the budget and asked for any comments. Some questions were asked by councilmembers on the movement of monies in line items. It was explained the funds could be moved around within each of the four programs, but that the utility accounts are supposed to be self-supporting by themselves. However, the sewer account was in the red last year and probably will be this year also. Dick Walters asked if it ran in the red before last year and was told it had not. Mayor Hoover told council he had given permission for the clerk to work on the budget at home.

Motion by Kinsinger and Walters to close the public hearing. All voted aye. Carried.

Motion by Kinsinger and Harland to approve Resolution #19-94, "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FISCAL BUDGET FOR 1994-1995." All voted aye. Carried.

Community input was asked for. Dick Walters and Ken Bernauer commented. Motion by Kinsinger and Harland to adjourn the meeting at 6:24 p.m. All voted aye. Carried.
