

March 21, 1994

The Buffalo, IA City Council met in special session on Monday, March 21, 1994, at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Phil C. Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Tom Harland, Jr., David Kinsinger, Dick Nissen and Betty Walters, Absent was Josie Collins. Purpose of the meeting was a discussion with officials from Linwood Mining & Mineral Corp. on reissuance of their \$2.3 million industrial development revenue bonds.


Council and Mayor discussed the following items with Jim Teel, Greg Bush and Larry Bush from Linwood Mining: Jet cleaning of the storm sewers, debris in the storm drains besides rock, offices and rooms built in the mine, building permits, water drainage problems, landfill lease, future possible annexations and rezoning, right-of-way ground cover, past council conflicts, future plans for entrances and exits into the area, truck traffic across the highway, future covering of truck loads, future cooperation between Linwood and the City, expected savings by reissuance of the bonds.


Motion by Harland and Kinsinger to approve the reissuance and set the date for a public hearing on the reissuance of the bonds. Voting aye were Harland, Kinsinger and Walters. Nissen voted nay and Collins was absent. Carried. City Clerk, Carol Bernauer, told Larry Bush she wishes their attorney to take care of the public notices, and he agreed. He said this would be considered the first hearing and the second would be at the regular meeting on May 02, 1994. Council agreed to this.

Motion by Walters and Harland to approve Resolution #20-94, "A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE FIVE (5) YEAR LEASE WITH LAFARGE FOR CITY PARK." All present voted aye. Carried.

Community input was asked for. Ralph Jewett gave some information from a meeting he had with an official at Linwood and Bernauer asked Greg Bush to contact the County Assessor and County Treasurer to get a statement of how much in tax dollars actually is paid to the City of Buffalo, from Linwood's tax payment.

Motion by Kinsinger and Nissen to adjourn the meeting at 8:31 p.m. All present aye. Absent, Collins. Carried.
