The Buffalo City Council met in special session on Thursday, May 26, 1994, at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Phil Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Josie Collins, Tom Harland, Jr., and Betty Walters. Absent were David Kinsinger and Dick Nissen.

Purpose of the special meeting was a public hearing to amend the current fiscal 1993-1994 budget. The Mayor declared the meeting open to public comments. No one had any comments for or against the amendment. Mayor then declared the public hearing closed.


Motion by Collins and Walters to approve Resolution #28-94, "A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CURRENT FISCAL 1993-1994 BUDGET." Voting yes were Collins, Harland and Walters. Absent were Kinsinger and Nissen. Motion carried.

Motion by Walters and Collins to advertise locally for the position of summer JTPA supervisor. All present voted yes. Carried. This will run from June 13 thru August 05, 32 hours per week maximum, \$8.58 per hour, no fringe benefits. Everything is paid thru JTPA. All applicants must be at least 18 years of age, a valid drivers license, show proof of citizenship, ability to get along with teenagers and to maintain mowers and hand tools. All applications must be received at City Hall no later than 4:00 p.m. on June 03, 1994. The position will be decided at the June 06 council meeting.

There was no community input.

Motion by Harland and Walters to adjourn the special meeting at 6:05 p.m. All present voted aye. Motion carried.
