

February 21, 1995

The Buffalo, IA City Council met in special session on Tuesday, February 21, 1995, at 6:34 p.m. with Mayor Phil Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Tom Harland, Jr., Dave Kinsinger, Dick Nissen and Betty Walters. Josie Collins arrived a few minutes later.

Council, Mayor and Police Chief Gage Adams went over the police part of the budget. Council decided there is not enough in his budget to purchase a new squad car at this time. In June, there could be funds left in this budget to add to funds being put in next years budget for another squad car. At 8:15 p.m. council continued on with the rest of the budget. After studying the figures in different departments, motion was made by Kinsinger and Collins to approve the budget and **adopted Resolution #12-95, "A RESOLUTION TO SET A DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING FOR FISCAL 1995-96 BUDGET."** All voted aye. Carried. The public hearing will be Monday, March 13, 1995, 6:00 p.m. City Hall.

Community input was given by Judy Hammons concerning the Community Center; Harland, concerning a contractor; Collins, concerning handicapped parking at St. Peters Church. Motion by Collins and Walters to adjourn the meeting at approximately 9:00 p.m. All voted yes. Carried.
