The Buffalo, IA City Council met in special session on Tuesday, May 09, 1995, at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Phil Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Josie Collins, Dave Kinsinger, Dick Nissen and Betty Walters. Absent, Tom Harland, Jr.

The letter from the Iowa Dept. of Natural Resources concerning the Buffalo Waste-Water Treatment Plant was discussed with the council and special city attorney. The letter came after an inspection at the treatment plant. Kinsinger said due to the flagrant violations at the plant, he made the motion to terminate Protecs contract effective immediately. He said the public had elected the council to their positions to do what is best for the city. Collins seconded the motion. Voting yes were Collins, Kinsinger, Nissen and Walters. Harland was absent. Motion carried. The locks on the gate at the plant and the two lift stations will be changed tonight and the building locks will be changed on the next day, (Wednesday). Mayor and Police Chief will meet them at the plant early Wednesday morning and allow them to remove their computer. The Police Chief will escort the Public Works Director tonight to change the locks.

Community input was asked for. There was discussion about the locks. Motion by Walters and Collins to adjourn the meeting at approximately 6:45 p.m. All present voted yes. Absent, Harland. Motion carried.
