The City Council of the City of Buffalo, IA met in special session on Wednesday, July 12, 1995, at 6:03 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Phil Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Josie Collins, Tom Harland, Jr., Dave Kinsinger and Dick Nissen. Absent, Betty Walters.

Purpose of the special meeting was for appointments to the Buffalo Community Center Commission.

Mayor Hoover recommended for council approval for the following names: Lois Davis, Charles Shreeves, Paula Schwartz, Ron Brookhart and Amy Haines.

Motion by Collins to approve Resolution #35-95, "A RESOLUTION FOR APPOINTMENT." Motion died for lack of a second.

Motion by Collins to approve Resolution #36-95, "A RESOLUTION FOR APPOINTMENT." Motion died for lack of a second.

Motion by Collins and Nissen to approve Resolution #37-95, "A RESOLUTION FOR APPOINTMENT." Voting yes were Collins and Nissen. Voting no, Harland and Kinsinger. Walters was absent. Motion not carried.

Motion by Collins and Nissen to approve Resolution #38-95, "A RESOLUTION FOR APPOINTMENT." Voting yes were Collins and Nissen. Voting no, Harland and Kinsinger. Walters was absent. Motion not carried.

Motion by Collins and Nissen to approve Resolution #39-95, "A RESOLUTION FOR APPOINTMENT." Voting yes were Collins and Nissen. Voting no, Harland and Kinsinger. Walters was absent. Motion not carried.

Harland and Kinsinger said they are not for appointing anyone to the Commission at this time and want all the problems worked out before putting anyone else on it. There has been a lot of problems and it would not be fair putting new people on the Commission to try to deal with them. A meeting will be scheduled with the whole Commission when all of council can be present to work out the problems and try to get things running smoothly again. This will be scheduled when Walters can also be present.

Raises for part time employees was discussed. After some time, motion was made by Kinsinger and Harland that the immediate supervisor of an employee, be it part time or full time, will rate and evaluate the employee and if a raise is justified, the supervisor will bring it to the Employee Relations Committee for consideration. Voting aye were Collins, Harland and Kinsinger. Nissen abstained and Walters was absent. Motion carried.

Community input was asked for. Ron Brookhart, Ralph Jewett, Shari Nissen, Mae Brookhart, Chuck Shreeves and Dwain Bollman gave input.

Motion by Kinsinger and Collins to adjourn the meeting at approximately 6:57 p.m. Voting aye were Collins, Harland and Kinsinger. Nissen abstained and Walters was absent. Motion carried.
