The City Council of Buffalo, IA met in special session on Wednesday, September 20, 1995, at 6:02 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Phil Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Josie Collins, Tom Harland, Jr., Dave Kinsinger, Dick Nissen and Betty Walters. Absent, none.

Purpose of the special meeting was to decide the funding for the special water project and other listed items.

Motion by Harland and Walters to purchase the computer program package presented by Dwain Bollman for \$4808.00. All ayes. Carried. This will enable the public works department to have better access to utility maps, etc.

Bids were opened for the tractor backhoe. Bids were as follow: Gage Adams, \$4010.00: Bill Sheeder, \$3700.00: Sand Prairie Construction, \$5273.00: Collins Concrete, \$6000.00. Motion by Walters and Harland to accept the high bid of Collins Concrete. Voting aye were Harland, Kinsinger, Nissen and Walters. Collins abstained. Motion carried.


Motion by Collins and Harland to approve Resolution #52-95, "A RESOLUTION ALLOWING LAFARGE TO HAVE BEER IN CITY PARK FOR THEIR ANNUAL PICNIC AND BASEBALL GAME." All members voted yes. Carried.

Motion by Kinsinger and Harland to have Trick or Treat night in Buffalo the same night as Davenport has theirs. All ayes. Carried.


Council and Mayor discussed the options for funding of the special water project. It will cost approximately \$1,000,000 and the council has pledged the landfill host benefit funds towards this project. There was discussion of selling \$750,000.00 in bonds and using the payments from the landfill to make the payments yearly on them, and if we should have any unexpected expenses with the project, it should be covered with this bonding amount. Council will have the clerk contact the bond attorneys and begin the procedure for selling water revenue bonds. Motion by Walters and Kinsinger to approve Resolution #53-95, "A RESOLUTION TO FINANCE WATER PROJECT." All members voted yes. Motion carried.

Walters told council of a call from the Community Center Commission for their thoughts on purchasing a new bingo machine. This will be on the October agenda. Motion by Harland and Kinsinger to adjourn the meeting at 6:41 p.m. All voted yes. Carried.
