The Buffalo, IA City Council met in special session on Tuesday, November 14, 1995, at 7:01 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Phil Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Josie Collins, Tom Harland, Jr., Dave Kinsinger, Dick Nissen and Betty Walters. Absent, none.

Motion by Collins and Kinsinger to go into closed session per Iowa Code 21.5-1(c), at 7:03 p.m. Voting yes were Collins, Harland, Kinsinger, Nissen and Walters. All yes. Motion carried.

Council returned to open session at 8:01 p.m. with all councilmembers and Mayor present. Roll call was taken at 8:04 p.m. by the city clerk, and all councilmembers and Mayor Hoover were present.

Motion by Kinsinger and Harland to approve D.A.T.A.'s Drug Testing Program for all employees with C.D.L. licenses and to appoint the city clerk as the contact person. All members voted aye. Carried. All testing related information will be kept locked in a separate secured area.

Motion by Kinsinger and Harland to approve the 1996 medical insurance contract for the employees, with an approximate 32% decrease in the premiums due to a revised formula. All councilmembers voted aye. Carried. Clerk is to sign the contract.

Motion by Harland and Collins to approve the beer renewal for Caseys Store. All members voted aye. Carried.

No community input was given. Motion by Kinsinger and Harland to adjourn the meeting at 8:16 p.m. All councilmembers voted yes. Motion carried.
