The City Council of Buffalo, IA met in special session on Thursday, February 15, 1996, at 6:33 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Phil Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Tom Harland, Jr., Dave Kinsinger, Kent Roe and Betty Walters.

Purpose of the special meeting was to work on the fiscal 1996-97 budget. Council agreed to work only until 8:00 p.m. this evening on the budget and the following items. Motion by Kinsinger and Anderson to mail letters to the Secretary of State and the State Treasurer regarding our special census, as required by the State of Iowa. All members voted aye. Carried.


Motion by Harland and Anderson to send Rick Fielder to wastewater school for twelve weeks, one day a week. Voting aye were Harland and Anderson. Voting nay were Roe, Kinsinger and Walters. Motion not carried.

Council worked with the budget until 8:00 p.m. Council agreed to meet in special session on Tuesday, February 20 at 6:30 p.m. and again on Thursday, February 22, at 6:30 p.m. to continue working with the budget.

Motion by Kinsinger and Roe to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 p.m. Majority of members voted yes. Motion carried.
