The City Council of Buffalo, IA met in special session on Thursday, February 22, 1996, at 6:31 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Pro-Tem Tom Harland, Jr. presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Tom Harland, Jr., Dave Kinsinger, Kent Roe and Betty Walters. Absent, none. Purpose of the special meeting was to work on the fiscal 1996-97 budget.

Council agreed to work on the budget until 8:00 p.m. After some time, council agreed to have the final budget meeting on Monday, February 26, 1996, at 6:30 p.m. and schedule the public hearing, if possible, for March 14. Council then discussed the I.M.F.O.A. meeting in Des Moines in April and October and motion was made by Kinsinger and Roe to allow the city clerk and Walters to attend these meetings this year. Voting yes were Anderson, Harland, Kinsinger and Roe. Walters abstained. Motion carried.

The Labor Employee/Relations Committee will meet on Thursday, February 29, at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall. The Water/Sewer/Solid Waste Committee will meet on Wednesday, February 28, 1996, at 6:30 p.m. at the Morton Building, 402-3rd Street.

Public input was asked for. Holly Lopez and Dick Walters were the only residents present. Betty Walters asked council for permission to use the city phones to make her long distance calls for another senior housing project so it wouldn't be on her phone bill. Council agreed to this.

Motion by Walters and Roe to adjourn the meeting at 7:38 p.m. Majority voted yes. Motion carried.
