The City Council of Buffalo, IA met in special session on ¹² ~~Thursday~~ ^{MONDAY}, February 26, 1996, at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Pro-Tem Tom Harland, Jr. presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Tom Harland, Jr., Dave Kinsinger, Kent Roe and Betty Walters. Absent, none. Purpose of the special meeting was to finish the fiscal 1996-97 budget.

Council finished the budget, discussed the figures, and agreed to keep the same tax rate as last year, which is 6.65 per thousand of valuation, and 3.00375 for ag land tax. Motion by Kinsinger and Roe to approve Resolution #13-96, "A RESOLUTION TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE FISCAL 1996-1997 BUDGET." This will be March 14 at 6:30 p.m. All members voted yes. Motion carried. City Clerk will finish up the figures with time as needed.

No dates were set for any special meetings other than the public hearing. Public input was asked for. Holly Lopez questioned why Mayor Hoover wasn't allowed to attend the IMFOA meetings with the Clerk and Walters. Motion by Walters and Kinsinger to adjourn the meeting at 6:50 p.m. Majority voted yes. Motion carried.
