
The City Council of Buffalo, IA met in special session on Thursday, April 04, 1996, at 6:02 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Phil Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Kent Roe, Dave Kinsinger and Betty Walters. Absent, Tom Harland, Jr. Purpose of the special meeting was to interview final applicants for the vacant police officer position.


The Council, Mayor and Police Chief Gage Adams interviewed four applicants for the position at fifteen minute intervals.
