Items number 3,4, and 5 were tabled.

Motion by Roe, seconded by Harland to approve Resolution #29-96, "A RESOLUTION ALLOWING ALTORFER MACHINE CO. TO HAVE BEER IN CITY PARK FOR THEIR COMPANY-FAMILY PICNIC." All ayes. Carried.

Motion by Kinsinger, seconded by Roe to approve Resolution #30-96, "A RESOLUTION ALLOWING LAFARGE TO HAVE BEER IN CITY PARK FOR THEIR ANNUAL PICNIC AND BASEBALL GAME. All ayes. Carried.


Resolution to give Ralph Jewett a increase in pay was discussed. Mayor would like the the Ordinance Committee to meet sometime before the next regular council meeting because in the City Code Book, Title I - Policy and Administration - Chapter 4, Article 5, Line 14 states he must keep a written statement of designation of the person in charge of city operations in his absence. You are going to have to delete this out of the ordinance. This was passed on Oct. 1992. The Ordinance Committee will be looking into this code at there next meeting. Motion by Walters, seconded by Anderson to approve Resolution #31-96, "A RESOLUTION TO GIVE RALPH JEWETT A INCREASE IN PAY, 50¢ a hour." All ayes. Carried. Decision on bids for termite treatment at the Civic Center was discussed. Motion by Harland, seconded by Roe to accept the Terminix bid. All ayes. Carried.


