The Council and City Union Attorney Robert Boeye met with Gary Dunham of the Teamsters Local #238 and employees represented by the union. Council will take these under advisement and meet again with the union and representatives on Wednesday, December 11, at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall.

The Council will meet in special session on December 23 at 5:30 p.m. for a personnel issue.

At 6:13 p.m. motion was made by Walters and seconded by Anderson, to go into closed session per Iowa Code 21.5(c), "litigation" and then per Iowa Code 20.17 "Public Employment Relations, (Collective Bargaining) Procedures:" Voting yes were Anderson, Harland, Kinsinger, Roe and Walters. Motion carried. City Clerk Carol Bernauer left the meeting after the first closed session was finished. Council began the second closed session at 6:47 p.m. and adjourned the meeting at 7:25 p.m.
