The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Wednesday, January 08, 1997, at 5:34 p.m. with Mayor Pro-Tem Tom Harland, Jr. presiding at City Hall. Mayor Phil Hoover was absent. Also present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Dave Kinsinger, Kent Roe and Betty Walters. Absent, none. Purpose of the special meeting was to decide on three (3) grievances filed by Rick Fielder and to go into closed session for collective bargaining. Also present was City Union Attorney Robert Boeye and Gary Dunham.

Gary Dunham, Teamsters Representative was present for Rick Fielder. Motion made by Kinsinger and Anderson to deny all three grievances filed by Fielder. Voting yes were Anderson, Kinsinger, Roe and Walters. Voting no, Harland. Motion carried. Council and Union will go to arbitration from this point.

Council discussed an insurance plan with two gentlemen who were present for the meeting, Joe Zilly and Douglas Wier. Motion was made by Anderson and Roe to go into closed session per Iowa Code 20.17(3) PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS (COLLECTIVE BARGAINING, PROCEDURES) at 6:33 p.m. Voting yes were Anderson, Roe, Harland, Kinsinger and Walters. Voting no, none. Motion carried.

Council returned to open session at 8:31 p.m. with all members present except Mayor Hoover. Motion by Roe and Anderson to adjourn the meeting at 8:31 p.m. All members voted yes. Motion carried.
