

January 13, 1997

The City Council of Buffalo, IA met in special session on Monday, January 13, 1997, at 6:17 p.m. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Dave Kinsinger, Kent Roe and Betty Walters. Absent were Mayor Phil Hoover and Councilmember Tom Harland, Jr. As Councilmember Walters has more council seniority, she conducted the meeting. The purpose of the special meeting was to interview applicants for the position of wastewater treatment plant operator.

Motion by Roe and Kinsinger to approve the renewal of the liquor license for the Community Center when they have all their paperwork turned in. All present voted yes. Absent, Harland. Carried.

Council then interviewed two applicants for the position. Another person who was scheduled had decided to decline the interview.

After the interviews, motion was made by Roe and Kinsinger to hire Gregg Shaw at a beginning hourly rate of \$13.00 per hour. When his six months probation period is up, he will be given a .50¢ per hour increase pending Bollmans review and evaluation, plus a .45¢ an hour union contract increase. All members present voted yes. Motion carried.

Police Chief Gage Adams had a new part time police officer sworn in by the City Clerk. His name is Terry Behning and will be riding with an officer to get familiar with our city.

Motion by Roe and Kinsinger to adjourn the meeting at 7:14 p.m. All present voted aye. Absent, Harland. Motion carried.
