


January 23, 1997

The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met on Thursday, January 23, 1997, at 5:34 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Phil C. Hoover presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Tom Harland, Jr., Dave Kinsinger, Kent Roe and Betty Walters. Absent, none. Purpose of the special meeting was to go into closed session per Iowa Code 21.5(i).

Motion by Kinsinger and Roe to approve the request for rezoning of the Groharing property in Scott County. All ayes. Carried. Motion by Walters and Harland to approve Resolution #02-97. Voting yes were Anderson, Harland, Kinsinger, Roe and Walters. Motion carried. Motion by Harland and Anderson to go into closed session per Iowa Code 21.5(i): To evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose appointment, hiring, performance or discharge is being considered when necessary to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation and that individual requests a closed session. Voting yes were Anderson, Harland, Kinsinger, Roe and Walters. Motion carried. Council went into closed session at 5:40 p.m.

Council returned to open session at 5:49 p.m. with Mayor Hoover and all councilmembers present. Motion made by Harland and Roe to approve termination of John Isham's employment with the City effective this date at 5:50 p.m. for causes discussed in closed session. Voting yes were Anderson, Roe, Kinsinger, Harland and Walters. Motion carried.

Public input was discussed. Walters said the Community Center is making a profit now. Harland said we need to hire another person, as the public works is short-handed. Kinsinger asked the Mayor about the absence of his Mayors reports. Motion made by Roe and Anderson to adjourn the meeting at 6:03 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried.
