

February 10, 1997

The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Monday, Feb. 10, 1997, at 5:33 p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Phil Hoover and Mayor Pro-Tem Tom Harland, Jr., were absent. Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Kent Roe and Betty Walters were present. Dave Kinsinger was absent, but arrived at 6:02 p.m.

As Walters has more council position seniority, it was approved for her to conduct the meeting.

Motion by Anderson and Roe to allow each spokesman on his part of the budget a maximum of 25 minutes. All ayes. Carried.

After council had examined all the budget sheets and discussed it with Gage Adams, Dwain Bollman and the City Clerk, motion was made by Roe and Anderson to approve Resolution #05-97 and set the date for the public hearing on the fiscal 1997-98 budget for March 11, 1997, at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall. The tax asking rate will be the same rate as the previous two years. Voting yes were Anderson, Kinsinger, Roe and Walters. Absent, Harland. Motion carried.

Public input was asked for. Bollman gave council an update on Linwood Mining and their projects there that do not have building permits and a difference of agreement on the requirements needed to obtain a permit. All correspondence will be sent to the city attorney.

Motion made by Roe and Kinsinger to adjourn the meeting at 6:25 p.m. All members present voted aye. Absent, Harland. Motion carried.
