The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Tuesday, March 11, 1997, at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Phil Hoover presiding at City Hall. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Dave Kinsinger, Kent Roe and Betty Walters. Absent, Tom Harland, Jr. Purpose of the special meeting was to hold a public hearing on the adoption of the fiscal 1997-1998 budget.

The Mayor declared the budget hearing open at 5:31 p.m. for comments for or against the proposed budget. No one was present to make any comments from the audience and no comments had been received in writing. Motion was made at 5:32 p.m. by Anderson and Roe to close the public hearing and adopt Resolution #07-97, adoption of the fiscal 1997-1998 budget as published. All members present voted yes. Absent, Harland. Motion carried.

After discussion between Council, Mayor and Dwain Bollman, motion was made by Kinsinger and Roe to sign the D.O.T. permit for Linwood Mining & Mineral Company's request for the overhead conveyor on Highway #22. Mayor Hoover will sign it. All present voted aye. Motion carried.


No one was present to apply for the City Park concession stand, so it was not discussed.

A special closed meeting will be held on Friday, March 14, at 5:30 p.m.


Public input was asked for. It was brought up about all the rock in the storm gutters along Highway #22 at Linwood and Lafarge. Mayor is to have the police dept. start giving out tickets to uncovered trucks leaving these places with rock or gravel, etc. in them.

Motion by Kinsinger and Roe to adjourn the meeting at 5:48 p.m. All present ayes. Carried.
