The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Tuesday, June 10, 1997, at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Phil Hoover was absent. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Dave Kinsinger, Kent Roe and Betty Walters. Absent, Tom Harland. As the Mayor and Mayor Pro-Tem were both absent, motion was made by Anderson and Roe to have Walters conduct the meeting as senior councilmember. All agreed. Carried.

Motion by Anderson and seconded by Roe to go into closed session per Iowa Code 21.5(c) to discuss strategy with counsel in matters that are presently in litigation or where litigation is imminent where its disclosure would be likely to prejudice or disadvantage the position of the governmental body in that litigation. Voting yes were Anderson, Kinsinger, Roe and Walters. Absent, Harland. Council went into closed session at 5:31 p.m.

Council returned to open session at approximately 6:07 p.m. Members present were Anderson, Kinsinger, Roe and Walters. Absent, Mayor Hoover and Harland. Kinsinger told the clerk to put a resolution on the July agenda to reduce the public works department work force by layoff procedure as listed in the union contract. Motion by Roe and Anderson to approve the renewal of cigarette permits for 1997-1998 for Caseys General Store, EZ Way Store and the Beach Pub. All present voted aye. Carried.

Motion by Roe and Walters to have a letter delivered to Fielder concerning the arbitrators decision, to be delivered tonight. All ayes. Carried.

Motion by Roe and Anderson to adjourn the meeting at 6:20 p.m. All present aye. Absent, Harland. Motion carried.
