


November 05, 1997


The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met on Wednesday, November 05, 1997, at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall in special session. Mayor Phil Hoover presided. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Tom Harland, Jr., and Betty Walters. Resignations were received on November 05 from Dave Kinsinger and Kent Roe.

There was discussion on construction of a new boat ramp and dock. The present one at Main Street will be removed and a new one put in just slightly to the West of the old one. After considerable discussion, motion was made by Anderson and Harland to approve the bid from Collins Concrete Co. for \$8,700 and McCleary Excavating Co. for \$3750. This was the only bid received for the project. Council agreed that a written guarantee must be given to us that this ramp will be dropped in and be workable from the park board specs; the park board members must put boats in and approve payment when the project is finished. No payment will be made until this is all completed, inspected and approved by the park board. All voted aye. Carried.

Motion by Anderson and Harland to approve the renewal of Caseys Store's beer and Sunday license. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Public input was asked for. Dick Walters asked questions about the rock under the boat ramp. Motion made by Harland and Walters to adjourn the meeting at 5:57 p.m. All voted aye. Motion carried.
