The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session at City Hall on Wednesday, January 28, 1998, at 6:02 p.m., with Mayor Betty Walters presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Mitch Greer, Tom Harland, Jr., Ted Teel. Absent, Bill Sheeder. Purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the budget and other items.

Motion was made by Anderson and Teel to approve the renewal of the Buffalo Community Center's liquor license. All present voted yes. Carried.

There was discussion of the public works logs. Motion made by Harland and Greer that the employees do not have to continue doing daily hourly logs. Dwain Bollman will turn in a weekly report covering the highlights of the weeks jobs. All present voted yes. Motion carried.

The fiscal 1998-1999 budget was discussed. Council agreed to have the clerk work up the figures, keeping the same tax rate as last year. This will be discussed further at the regular February meeting. The fire department had turned in their budget requests earlier this month.

Special meetings were scheduled for February 04, 1998, at 6:00 p.m. at the Morton building to discuss street work and a date will be set for the Ordinance Committee to meet.

No one was present for public input. Motion made by Anderson and Harland to adjourn the meeting at 7:00 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried.
