The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Wednesday, February 04, 1998, at City Hall at 5:31 p.m. with Mayor Betty Walters presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Mitch Greer, Tom Harland, Jr., Bill Sheeder and Ted Teel.

Robin Guenther was present to give Council the price for boat dock to be installed at Front Street and Main Street. The price is the same as was quoted last fall. Motion made by Anderson and Teel to approve the boat dock and exclude the previous clause of guarantee. All ayes. Motion carried.

The street committee said their meeting at 5:00 p.m. was to gather information only and are not presenting anything at this time.


Motion by Harland and Sheeder to approve Resolution #10-98, "A RESOLUTION APPROVING TERRY BEHNINGS PROBATIONAL PERIOD AND IS NOW A PERMANENT FULL TIME POLICE OFFICER". Voting yes were Greer, Sheeder, Harland, Anderson and Teel. Motion carried.

Council discussed the fiscal 1998-1999 budget for the city. Motion was then made by Harland and Anderson to approve Resolution #11-98, "A RESOLUTION SETTING THE DATE FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE FISCAL 1998-1999 BUDGET". This will be on March 11 at 5:30 p.m. Voting yes were Teel, Greer, Sheeder, Anderson and Harland. Motion carried. The levy rate will remain the same as this year.

Public input was asked for. There was discussion of more storage space needed for all the city vehicles and equipment. No additional special meetings were scheduled.

Motion made by Harland and Anderson to adjourn the meeting at 6:12 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried.
