

March 18, 1998

The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Wednesday, March 18, 1998, at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Betty Walters presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Mitch Greer, Tom Harland, Jr., Ted Teel. Bill Sheeder was absent.

Council discussed the lighting project at City Park. Todd Adams, as a member of the park board, was present to answer questions. He said the board is aware this will use all the parks funds until July. Motion was made by Harland, seconded by Greer, to approve the bid of \$22,575.00 from Davenport Electric Contract Company. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

As the contract is expired for the park concession stand, motion was made by Harland and seconded by Teel, to advertise for bids for a one year contract for the concession stand. All present voted aye. Motion carried. Bids must be received at City Hall no later than noon on Friday, April 03 and will be approved at the regular meeting on Monday, April 06. The stand must be open for all ball games at the park during the spring and summer this year.

One bid was received for the 1989 Ford fire department van. Motion made by Anderson, seconded by Harland, to accept the bid from Koehler Electric, Inc. in the amount of \$7,210.00. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

Terry Adams, Fire Chief, had five bids for a new one ton, 4 wheel drive pickup for the fire dept. Bids were: Krieger Motors, GMC, 22335.48: Lujacks, CHEVY, 21,444.00: Bob Ericksens, CHEVY, 21,317.27: Dahl Ford, FORD, 23,441.00: and Key, DODGE, 25,009.00. Motion made by Anderson and Harland to approve Terry's recommendation of Ericksen's CHEVY for 21,317.27. All voted aye. Absent, Sheeder. The \$7,210 from the sale of the van will be applied to the purchase, the fire dept. will pay \$1,023.27 from their dance fund, and \$13,541.00 will come from reserves. This includes a few options that were added.

Public input was asked for. Brandy and Tiffany Harland were present. Ted Teel asked about cleanup in yards and elsewhere in town. No new meetings were scheduled.

Motion made by Harland and Anderson to adjourn the meeting at 5:51 p.m. All present voted aye. Absent, Sheeder. Motion carried.
