

April 27, 1998

The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, April 27, 1998, at City Hall with Mayor Betty Walters presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Mitch Greer, Tom Harland, Jr., Bill Sheeder and Ted Teel. Absent, none.

The purpose of the special meeting was to fill the vacancy in the public works department. The Councilmembers had individually reviewed each application that had been received at City Hall prior to this meeting. After discussion, motion was made by Harland and seconded by Teel, to hire Richard Derrickson to fill this position, as he has been employed for approximately three years on a part-time basis and has been involved in many of the jobs that are required in this position. This is Resolution #20-98. Voting yes were all members on a roll call vote. Carried. Derrickson will be on a 90 day probation, beginning hourly rate will be \$10.50 per hour, with a .50¢ an hour raise after the 90 days, along with union raises in July. He will receive all benefits as specified in the union contract. He will begin May 04 on a full time basis and begin his seniority on that date. Motion was made by Harland and seconded by Greer to approve Resolution #21-98, "A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT KAY PASCHEDAG TO THE PARK BOARD". All members voted yes on a roll call vote. Carried. This is effective immediately.

Public input was asked for. Greer said the scouts will begin their voluntary cleanup of the City on May 23 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and consist of a total of approximately 33 scouts and adults. The City will furnish bags, gloves and refreshments. Dwain Bollman told Council of a problem with the fence at the Mini-Park and a neighbor. Council agreed to have the fence torn out, as there is no requirement for the City to have a fence there. City employees will tear the fence out as quickly as possible. Teel apologized to Mayor Walters concerning the letters that were sent out for cleanup, as he read the policy in the City Code book. Motion was made by Greer and seconded by Harland to adjourn the meeting at 5:54 p.m. All members voted aye. Motion carried.
