The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session at City Hall on May 21, 1998, at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Betty Walters presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Mitch Greer, Tom Harland, Jr., Bill Sheeder and Ted Teel. Absent, none.

After discussion, motion was made by Harland and seconded by Sheeder to approve Resolution #23-98, "A RESOLUTION FOR WAGES". Voting yes were Anderson, Greer, Teel, Harland and Sheeder. Motion carried.

The position of building inspector was discussed. Motion was made by Harland and Anderson to advertise for a part time building inspector with applications accepted until noon on Friday, May 29. All voted yes. Motion carried. This will be a part time position with no benefits. Hours and wages are negotiable.

Public input was asked for. Mayor Walters told the Council some new rules concerning emergencies when Scott County is involved and the Mobile Command Unit is involved. More information will be coming to the Council. The clerk told Council there will be a Board of Adjustment meeting at City Hall on May 27 at 6:00 p.m. for Doug Long. The Park Board meeting will be held elsewhere that night.

Motion was made by Anderson and Harland to adjourn the meeting at approximately 7:40 p.m. All voted aye. Motion carried.
