The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Tuesday, June 09, 1998, at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Pro-Tem Paula Anderson presiding. Mayor Betty Walters was absent. Councilmembers present were Mitch Greer, Tom Harland, Jr., Bill Sheeder and Ted Teel. Absent, none. Purpose of the special meeting was to interview applicants for the position of building inspector for Buffalo.

The Council interviewed two applicants. After the interviews the Council discussed the qualifications of both applicants and the position. Motion was made by Sheeder and seconded by Teel to approve Resolution #24-98, "APPOINTMENT OF BUILDING INSPECTOR FOR BUFFALO". The building inspector will be Tom Zuber, on a trial basis for 90 days. He will be paid \$15.00 per hour, to be paid monthly, upon receipt of a submitted timesheet to the public works director or the city clerk. He will be responsible to the public works director. Anyone needing a permit must now get it from Mr. Zuber. His phone number will be available at 381-2226 or 381-3530, week-days. Voting yes were Greer, Harland, Sheeder, Teel. Voting no, Anderson. Motion carried. Anderson would like the position to remain in the public works dept.

Motion was made by Greer and seconded by Anderson to approve the renewal of the beer license and Sunday permit for Clark's Landing. All ayes. Carried.

Public input was asked for. Greer asked if the yards had been cleaned up that letters were sent out about to the residents. This will be checked further. An Employees Relations Committee meeting will be on June 23 at 5:30 p.m. at the Morton Building. Motion was made by Anderson and Greer to adjourn the meeting at 7:15 p.m. All ayes. Carried.
