

September 15, 1998

The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session at 4:58 p.m. on Tuesday, September 15, 1998, at City Hall with Mayor Betty Walters presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Mitch Greer, Bill Sheeder and Ted Teel. Absent, none. The purpose of the special meeting was to interview applicants for the position of police officer and a possible decision to fill the vacancy.

Council interviewed four applicants for the position. After discussion, motion was made by Anderson, seconded by Teel, to hire George Tessier for the position of police officer, effective September 15, 1998, to be on a one year probation, with a beginning salary of \$10.95 per hour, with an increase in pay in 6 months and at the end of 1 year pending Chief Adams evaluation. He will receive all benefits as specified in the union contract. At the end of his one year probation period, he will be allowed to join the Teamsters Police Union if he wishes. This is Resolution #29-98. Voting yes were Anderson, Sheeder and Teel. Voting no, Greer. Motion Carried. The other three applicants that are qualified for this position will be on a list that was made up by the council. If for some reason the position doesn't work out for Mr. Tessier then the next applicant on the list would be offered the position.

Set date(s) for special meetings. The Ordinance Committee will meet on Wed., September 23, 1998, at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall.

Public input was ask for. Ted Teel a reminder that he is still interested in purchasing the land that the old water tower sat on.

Motion by Greer, seconded by Anderson to adjourn the meeting at 6:20 p.m. All ayes. Motion Carried.
