The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Monday, October 05, 1998, at City Hall with Mayor Betty Walters presiding. Present were Councilmembers Paula Anderson, Mitch Greer, Bill Sheeder and Ted Teel. Absent, none. Time was 6:30 p.m.

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the request from the Buffalo Volunteer Ambulance Service to install an antenna on top of our new water tower. Also present to discuss this was Ron Millhollin from the BVAS; Dwain Bollman, Public Works Director; Bill McCullough, City Attorney.

Mr. Millhollin works in the communications business and answered questions from the group concerning the mechanics of the antenna and said the B.V.A.S. would have full responsibility for any and all liability that would be associated with the antenna. If the B.V.A.S. were to dissolve, the antenna could not be sold to anyone else for use by that group. Mr. McCullough informed the council that there is an ordinance for cities concerning control of antennas going up on city property, and the council should consider this. Mr. Millhollin was asking for an agreement to be drawn up between the B.V.A.S. and the City of Buffalo. After more discussion, the motion was made by Teel and seconded by Greer to have the agreement drawn up after we pass the ordinance first. We will receive the ordinance after he prepares it. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Anderson and Greer to adjourn the meeting at 7:05 p.m. All voted aye. Motion carried.
