

March 11, 1999

The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Thursday, March 11, 1999, at City Hall at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Betty Walters presiding. Councilmembers present were Mitch Greer, Kent Roe, Bill Sheeder and Ted Teel. Absent, none.

Purpose of the special meeting was to hold a public hearing for comments for or against the proposed fiscal 1999-2000 city budget. Motion was made by Roe and seconded by Sheeder to open the public hearing at 6:01 p.m. All voted aye. Carried. As no one had any comments, motion was made by Greer and Roe to close the public hearing. All voted aye. Carried.

Motion was made by Roe and seconded by Teel to approve Resolution #8-99, "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FISCAL 1999-2000 BUDGET." Voting yes were Roe, Teel, Sheeder and Greer. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Roe and seconded by Greer to approve the first reading of Ordinance #362, "AN ORDINANCE FOR OVERHEAD LIGHTING FEES AT CITY PARK." Voting to approve were Greer, Teel, Roe and Sheeder. Motion carried. Motion was made by Roe and seconded by Teel to suspend the rules, waive the second and third readings, and adopt Ordinance #362. Voting yes were Roe, Greer, Sheeder and Teel. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Roe and seconded by Greer, to approve Resolution #9-99, "A RESOLUTION AWARDED A TWO YEAR CONTRACT TO MISSY BOWERS AND JODI TEEL FOR THE CONCESSION STAND AT CITY PARK." Voting yes were Sheeder, Roe and Greer. Teel abstained. Motion carried.

There was no public input. Motion was made by Roe and Greer to adjourn the meeting at 6:04 p.m. All voted aye. Motion carried.
