
The Zoning Board of the City of Buffalo, Iowa, met on Monday, October 25, 1999, at City Hall with the following members present: Ray Farley, Daryl Buffington, Marie Derrickson, Ray Martinez, Sr., and Eldon Mosier. Dora Finkbeiner was absent. Also present were Bobby Kautz, Bill Yoder, Kevin Guizar and Dwain Bollman. Purpose of the meeting was to rezone a section of property owned by Margaret Kautz, at the request of Bobby Kautz, Power of Attorney for Mrs. Kautz. The area is 6.86 acres and requested it be zoned to "E" Local Business in order to have a business there of storage inside and outside of vehicles such as boats, campers, recreational vehicles, antique cars and trucks and any other vehicles on wheels. A large new storage building has been constructed on the site. The meeting began at 6:00 p.m.

The meeting was advertised as required by law and the required letters were sent and no comments had been received against the rezoning, and several comments had been received in favor of the rezoning.


There was discussion between Mr. Kautz and the boardmembers. Motion was made by Buffington and seconded by Martinez to approve the request for the rezoning and forward the request on to the City Council for their approval. Voting yes were Buffington, Martinez, Farley, Derrickson and Mosier. Absent, Finkbeiner. Motion was carried.

Motion was made by Farley and seconded by Buffington to adjourn the meeting at 6:08 p.m. All present voted aye. Motion carried.
