



The City Council of Buffalo, Iowa, met in special session on Tuesday, March 14, 2000, at 5:01 p.m. with Mayor Phil Hoover presiding. Councilmembers present were Todd Adams, Mitch Greer, Dave Kimes and Bill Sheeder. Ted Teel was absent. Purpose of the special meeting was to have a public hearing for the fiscal 2000-2001 budget.

Mayor Hoover announced the meeting open for comments for or against the adoption of the proposed fiscal 2000-2001 budget. No one was present from the community to comment. Greer asked if additional funds could be put back in the police salary line item. This would have to come from the fire budget, ambulance budget or street lighting budget. Towards the end of the new budget, the Council will have to decide on this item. Mayor announced the public hearing was closed.

Motion was made by Greer and seconded by Adams to approve Resolution #09-2000, "A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FISCAL 2000-2001 BUDGET". Voting yes were Adams, Kimes, Greer and Sheeder. Absent, Teel. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Adams and Greer to adjourn the meeting at 5:09 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried.
