



The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Monday, April 02, 2001, at 6:42 p.m. at City Hall with Councilmembers Teel, Greer, Roe and Sheeder. Absent, Mayor Hoover and Mayor ProTem Kimes. City Attorney William McCullough said the Councilmembers present could elect one of the Councilmembers to be acting Mayor ProTem. Motion was made by Greer and Sheeder to appoint Teel to be acting Mayor ProTem for this meeting. All ayes. Carried.


Motion was made by Greer, seconded by Sheeder to go into closed session per Iowa Code 21.5(j) to discuss the purchase of particular real estate only where premature disclosure could be reasonably expected to increase the price the governmental body would have to pay for that property. Voting yes were Roe, Sheeder, Teel and Greer. Absent, Kimes. Motion carried. Council went into closed session at 6:43 p.m.

Motion was made at 6:59 to return to open session by Roe and Sheeder. Carried. Kimes arrived during the closed session. Council adjourned at 6:59 p.m.
