

April 11, 2001

The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Wednesday, April 11, 2001, at City Hall at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor ProTem Teel presiding. Councilmembers present were Greer, Kimes, Roe, Sheeder and Teel.

Motion was made by Roe and Greer to approve Missy Bowers to be awarded the bid for the City Park concession stand for one summer. All ayes. Carried.

Motion was made by Greer and Sheeder to approve Resolution #12-2001, "A RESOLUTION FOR INCREASE IN WAGES FOR VICTOR OBERTANCE". Voting yes were Kimes, Teel, Sheeder, Roe and Greer. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Roe and Greer to approve the "CityWide Cleanup Week" for the week of May 19 thru May 26. The City will rent a garbage packer and have the city divided into five zones with pickup in each zone one certain day each that week. The residents may take their own trash to the landfill at no charge on two Saturdays, May 19 and May 26. They must prove their residence in Buffalo, not be business trash, no hazardous materials, etc. Maps will be posted around town to show the divided zones, and the days for pickup in those zones. All voted aye. Carried.

There was discussion of the new fire station and the property owner we are working with to purchase from. He has agreed to sell us some additional footage, and the property must now be surveyed and appraised.


Roe asked where the extra funds were going to come from for the wastewater treatment sludge project bid that was awarded. It amounts to nearly \$100,000 extra that we had not counted on. This will be discussed at a finance committee meeting.

The following meetings were set up: Finance/Ordinance Committee, April 16, 6:00 p.m.: Employee Relations Committee, April 16, 7:00 p.m.


Public input was asked for. Clerk Carol Bernauer said the City Hall will be closed on April 23-25 for computer training. Roe discussed the Outing Club tax exemption.

Motion was made by Roe and Sheeder to adjourn the meeting at 6:08 p.m. All voted aye. Motion carried.
