
The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Wednesday, May 09, 2001, at 5:15 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor ProTem Teel presiding. Councilmembers present were Kimes, Roe, and Teel. Absent was Greer and Sheeder.

Two bids were received for flood cleanup. Overland Systems, Inc. bid an estimated cost of \$9600., not to exceed \$14,000. Bob Carter Excavating Inc. bid a price of \$27,230. Motion was made by Roe and Kimes to accept the bid of Overland Systems, with all present approving. Motion carried.


Bollman will use his discretion to tell Overland when to begin removal, but not until we are sure the water is going down and staying down. Greer arrived at 5:19 p.m.

The Council will meet in a closed session with Mr. Slater on May 30 concerning the purchase of property for a fire station. Motion made by Roe and Teel to adjourn the meeting at 5:26 p.m. All present voted aye. Absent, Sheeder. Motion carried.
