The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Monday, May 21, 2001, at 5:38 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor ProTem Teel presiding. Councilmembers present were Roe, Sheeder and Teel. Absent, Greer and Kimes.

Purpose of the special meeting was to appoint the City's authorized representative(s) for flood recovery.

Motion was made by Roe and Sheeder to approve Resolution #13-2001, "A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING CAROL BERNAUER AND DWAIN BOLLMAN TO BE THE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES FOR FLOOD RECOVERY WITH IOWA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIVISION AND THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE". Voting yes were Roe, Teel and Sheeder. Absent, Kimes and Greer. Motion carried.

Motion made by Sheeder and Teel to approve agreement with the provisions of the paperwork required by FEMA and IEMD. All present voted aye. Carried.

Public input was asked for. Roe asked Bollman if we have a new meter reader, and Bollman said we do. This will be his only job. He did accept applications for this job. Bollman told Council about the sinkhole on Utah Street and the steps that are being followed to correct it by Linwood Mining & Mineral Co.

Motion made by Roe and Teel to adjourn the meeting at 5:47 p.m. All present aye. Absent, Kimes and Greer. Motion carried.
