The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on Wednesday, May 30, 2001, at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Hoover presiding. Councilmembers present were Kimes, Roe, Sheeder and Teel. Greer was absent.

The meeting was declared open for a public hearing for comments on amending the fiscal 2000-2001 budget, as published in the Quad City Times newspaper. No comments were given and no written comments were received. Motion was made by Teel and Roe to close the public hearing and approve Resolution #14-2001, "A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL 2000-2001 BUDGET". Voting to approve were Sheeder, Kimes, Teel and Roe. Absent, Greer. Motion carried.


Motion was made by Sheeder and Teel to adjourn this portion of this meeting. All present aye. Carried.


There was discussion on a lease rental/purchase for a new squad car, the same as Blue Grass is involved in. As the Council just received the information tonight, motion was made by Roe and Teel to table this item to the regular meeting on June 04, and to check finances for the purchase of a new squad car. All present aye. Carried.

Motion was made by Kimes and Roe, not to approve Item #6 to go into closed session to discuss a purchase of property until there is a full Council. There will be a special closed session on Monday at 6:30 p.m. for this. All present aye. Carried.

Public input was asked for. Council agreed that all items concerning funds being used from the park funds should first go before the Park Board for their decision, rather than coming before the Council first. This should always be the procedure for the Park Board as a whole to vote on.

Motion was made by Teel and Roe to adjourn the meeting at 5:26 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried.
