The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met on August 13, 2001, at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Hoover presiding. Councilmen present were Greer, Kimes, Roe and Teel. Sheeder was absent.

Purpose of the special meeting was to hold a public hearing on the proposed purchase of real property and the construction of a new fire station.

Motion was made by Roe and Greer to close the regular meeting and open the public hearing for comments on the purchase of property and the construction bids. Terry Adams, Fire Chief, discussed the bids that were received for the project and his proposal of which bids to approve. He proposed that Quality Construction Co. be approved for Schedules "A", "B", and "F"; Ryan Associates be approved for Schedules "C" and "D"; D.E.C.C.O. be approved for Schedule "E".

Motion was made by Roe and Greer to approve Resolution #22-2001, "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF REAL PROPERTY". Voting yes were Greer, Kimes, Roe and Teel. Sheeder was absent. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Roe and Greer to approve Resolution #23-2001, "A RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR THE NEW FIRE STATION". Voting yes were Greer, Kimes, Roe and Teel. Sheeder was absent. Motion carried.

Public input was asked for. Kenny Bernauer asked if Terrys recommendations for the bids were accepted. Yes they were.

Motion was made by Roe and Teel to adjourn the meeting at 6:17 p.m. All present voted aye. Sheeder was absent. Motion carried.
