

March 14, 2002

The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on March 14, 2002, at 4:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Ted Teel absent, and Mayor ProTem Dave Kimes presiding. Councilmembers present were Dave Kimes, Kent Roe, Dana Jo Smith, Cathy Stowe, Larry Thein.

The special meeting was to hold a public hearing for comments concerning the fiscal 2002-2003 budget as proposed. Motion was made by Roe and Stowe to open the public hearing. All members voted yes on a roll call vote. Carried.

Donna Roe asked what was put in for the park board, and was told about the same as last year. Two members of the Buffalo Volunteer Ambulance Service asked the same question, and was told \$7,000, the same as last year. They asked when they should come back for the next budget, and was told it starts usually in early February.

A motion was made by Thein and Stowe to close the public hearing. All voted yes on a roll call vote. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Roe and Thein to approve Resolution #15-2002, "A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE FISCAL 2002-2003 BUDGET AS PROPOSED". Voting yes were Thein, Smith, Roe, Kimes and Stowe. Motion carried.

Public input was asked for. Donna Roe and Bonnie Remley discussed the park board meeting from the previous night that they had participated in, and got out of hand with a Councilmember that was there. After some time, motion was made by Roe and Stowe to have a special council meeting with the park board on March 27 at 5:30 p.m. Majority of the Council voted aye. Carried. Roe and Remley said they truly want to work with the Council on the skateboard issue, and they all have to get along.

Motion was made by Stowe and Roe to adjourn the meeting at 4:22 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried.
