

July 10, 2002

The City Council of Buffalo, IA met in special session on July 10, 2002, at 6:01 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Protem David Kimes presiding. Councilmembers present were David Kimes, Kent Roe and Larry Thein. Absent, Dana Smith and Cathy Stowe. Dana Smith arrived at 6:02 p.m.

Motion was made by Roe, seconded by Thein to approve the 3rd and final reading of Ordinance #378, "AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE TIME OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS TO 6:00 P.M.". Voting yes, Roe, Thien and Kimes. Voting no, Smith. Motion Carried. Absent Stowe.

Motion was made by Roe, seconded by Thein to go ahead with the street work. Voting yes, Kimes, Smith, Thein and Roe. Motion Carried. Absent, Stowe. Dwain told council that the money is in the budget for the street work. Will have to amend the budget for the sidewalk going up Jefferson Street. Last council meeting talked about seeing if could go thru the school changing the work order. This will not work out. Will put this out for bid and have a public hearing on Aug. 5th, 2002 at the regular council meeting. MSI will be doing the street work. Council received paper work on the cost and what streets would be done.

Motion was made by Roe, seconded by Thein to let Chad Pregracke have his Annual River Clean up on July 13th on the beach. All ayes. Motion Carried. Absent, Stowe. Chad Pregracke was present at the meeting. He told council about the scheduling of events and the procedure of setting up. Had concern about a group of people, about 30, that came last year and caused problems for him. Doesn't want the same thing to happen again. Smith said talked to Gage, told of how he will take care of the problems and will have extra police officers working that day. Chad thanked council for letting him have this event in Buffalo. He apologized for not letting the council know ahead of time, the mix up on the times and not going thru the correct procedure. Council appreciates all the work he does and thanked him for having the event in Buffalo.

There was no community input.

Motion was made by Roe, seconded by Thein to adjourn the meeting at 6:22 p.m. All ayes. Motion Carried. Absent, Stowe.
