

May 29, 2003

The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on May 29, 2003, at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor ProTem Walters presiding. Councilmembers present were Smith, Stowe and Walters. Absent were Mayor Teel and Councilmembers Roe and Thein.

No one present wished to give public input. Motion was made by Stowe and Walters, to close the regular meeting and open the meeting for public input on the amendment of the fiscal 2002-2003 budget. Voting yes were Stowe, Smith and Walters. Absent, Roe and Thein. Carried. The public hearing was opened at 5:31 p.m. Comments for or against the amendment were asked for, but none were given. Motion was made by Stowe and Walters to close the public hearing at 5:32 p.m. All present voted aye. Carried.

Motion was made by Smith and Stowe to approve Resolution #14-2003, "A RESOLUTION FOR AMENDMENT OF THE FISCAL 2002-2003 BUDGET." Voting yes were Smith, Walters and Stowe. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Stowe and Walters to approve the expenditure of \$4280.00 in the park board budget for new equipment for the Mini Park. Voting yes were Smith, Stowe and Walters. Absent, Thein and Roe. Carried.

Three bids were received for the new three year contract for garbage and recycle, effective July 01, 2003. The bids were from Jeffs Disposal, Prairie Waste and H & M Disposal. Motion was made by Stowe and Walters to approve the bid from H & M Disposal for the next three year contract. Voting yes were Walters, Stowe and Smith. Absent, Thein and Roe. Carried.

Item #10 was tabled as the Councilmember was not present. Public input was asked for. Bernauer said we have received good service from Prairie Waste in the past, and if we had problems, a phone call usually took care of it. There were comments about the new repair shop that was opened recently. Motion was made by Stowe and Smith to adjourn the meeting at 5:52 p.m. Voting yes were Walters, Smith and Stowe. Absent were Roe and Thein. Carried.
