The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on July 23, 2003, at 6:05 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor ProTem Betty Walters presiding. Mayor Ted Teel was absent. Councilmembers present were Kent Roe, Dana Jo Smith, Cathy Stowe and Betty Walters. Absent, Larry Thein.

No one present wished to give public input.

The Council previously met and interviewed candidates for the position of police officer. Motion was made by Roe and Stowe to approve Resolution #16-2003, "A RESOLUTION TO FILL THE VACANCY ON THE BUFFALO POLICE DEPARTMENT". Voting yes were Roe, Stowe, Walters and Smith. Absent, Thein. Motion carried. Terry Ferkel was hired for the vacancy, with a beginning hourly rate of \$13.45, a six month probation, and a .50¢ increase after the six month probation is completed.

Eliminating the time limit on council meetings was on the agenda. Motion was made by Roe, seconded by Stowe, that since this is at least the third time on the agenda, to continue the time limit of meetings and not change it, and leave it as is. Voting yes were Roe, Walters, Smith and Stowe. Absent, Thein. Carried.

There was no public input at the end of the meeting. Motion was made by Roe and Stowe to adjourn the meeting at 6:13 p.m. All present voted aye. Carried.
