

June 14, 2004

The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on June 14, 2004, at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Walters presiding. Councilmembers present were Mitch Greer, Judy Hammons, Dana Smith and Cathy Stowe. Absent, Larry Thein.

No one present had any public input. Three companies submitted bids for the electrical work at the Buffalo Activity Center for air conditioning. The bids ranged from \$20,990 to \$7650. Motion was made by Stowe and Smith to approve the bid from Abel Electric for \$7,650.00 All voted yes on a roll call vote. Absent, Thein. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Stowe and Hammons to approve the beer license renewal for Clark's Landing. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Stowe and Hammons to approve the third and final reading of Ordinance #391, "AN ORDINANCE BANNING GRASS BURNING..." Voting yes were Stowe, Greer, Hammons and Smith. Absent, Thein. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Stowe and Hammons to approve the third and final reading of Ordinance #390, "AN ORDINANCE FOR FEES FOR WATER AND ELECTRIC DISCONNECTS/RECONNECTS." Voting yes were Hammons, Smith, Stowe and Greer. Absent, Thein. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Stowe and Smith, to approve the third and final reading of Ordinance #392, "AN ORDINANCE FOR FEES FOR TEMPORARY ELECTRIC SERVICE..." Voting yes were Greer, Smith, Hammons and Stowe. Absent, Thein. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Stowe and Smith, to approve the third and final reading of Ordinance #393, "AN ORDINANCE FOR DISPOSITION OF FIRE EQUIPMENT..." Voting yes were Hammons, Greer, Smith and Stowe. Absent, Thein. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Stowe and Smith, to discuss Resolution #22-2004, "A RESOLUTION FOR FINES FOR NO LICENSES OR DISPLAY OF LICENSES FOR ANIMALS." Stowe said Thein and herself have spent many hours working on the resolutions for control of animals, and hoped they were not voted down. Voting for the Resolution were Stowe and Hammons. Voting against were Greer and Smith. Absent, Thein. Motion tied and not carried.

Motion was then made by Stowe and Smith to table the other resolutions for animals running at large and for fines for boarding fees for animals picked up. All present voted aye. Motion carried. These may go on a future agenda for consideration.

Public input was again asked for. Motion was made by Stowe and Greer to adjourn the meeting at 6:49 p.m. All present voted aye. Absent, Thein. Motion carried.
