

March 29, 2005

The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in special session on March 29, 2005, at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Walters presiding. Councilmembers present were Carson, Greer, Hammons and Wiese. Absent, Stowe. Purpose of the special meeting was to meet with members of the Buffalo Community Center Commission and discuss finances and operation of the building.

Public input was asked for and given by several members of the audience.

Motion was made by Hammons and Wiese to approve Resolution #8-2005, appointing Marie Derrickson to the Buffalo Community Center Commission, effective immediately. Voting yes were Greer, Carson, Wiese, Hammons. Absent, Stowe. Carried.

Motion was made by Carson and Greer to have Carson in charge of memorials and the office will order them. All voted aye. Carried. Motion was made by Carson and Hammons to refund the expense of a variance meeting for Doug Buchanan. All voted aye. Carried. Motion was made by Greer and Carson to approve the liquor license renewal for the Beach Pub. All ayes. Carried. Motion was made by Hammons and Greer that bills will be listed on all meeting agendas. All ayes. Carried.

Council then proceeded to discuss finances and operation of the Buffalo Community Center Commission and building. Lynn Kinkennon gave a report on finances of the annual Firemens Dance, expenses for cleaning of the building, rental contracts, etc. Greer asked if other rental facilities could be contacted for comparison of the rental and cleaning fees for the April meeting.

Public input was again asked for. Council wished to thank Tom Harland and his family for the annual Easter Egg Hunt that was held on Easter Sunday, and was informed that he will continue the event next year.

Motion was made by Greer and Hammons to adjourn the meeting at 8:24 p.m. All present voted aye. Absent, Stowe. Motion carried.
