The City Council of Buffalo, IA, met in regular session on June 06, 2005, at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Walters presiding. Councilmembers present were Carson, Greer, Hammons and Wiese. Absent, Stowe.

Motion by Carson, seconded by Hammons to approve the agenda. All ayes. Carried. Hammons made the motion that we amend the minutes (April 26), made the motion to bring it on the floor, made a motion that we amend the minutes of April 26 to delete the public input that was not supposed to be in there. Greer seconded the motion. All ayes. Carried.

Motion was made by Carson, seconded by Wiese to approve the minutes of May 02. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Hammons, seconded Wiese to discuss the bills. Motion made by Hammons and Wiese to pay the bills. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Hammons, seconded by Carson, to close the regular meeting and open the meeting to a public hearing for comments on the intention to issue Facility Revenue Bonds (Family Resources Project), Series 2005 (the "Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$1,250,000. The time was 7:45 p.m. All ayes. Carried.

Comments were given concerning the issuance of the bonds. Motion was made at approximately 8:00 p.m. by Wiese, seconded by Hammons, to close the public hearing and return to the regular meeting. All ayes. Carried. Motion was made by Carson, seconded by Wiese, to approve Resolution #10-2005, authorizing the issuance of said bonds. All present voted yes on a roll call vote. Absent, Stowe. Carried.

Motion was made by Carson, seconded by Greer, to let the 4th of July Committee use the Community Centers liquor license to sell beer in the City Park on July 03. All ayes. Carried. No paperwork has been received for this to date.

Motion made by Carson and Wiese to allow the Quad City Realtors to use the beach on July 15. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Greer and Hammons to approve Chad Agans bid for concession stand work. All ayes. Carried.

Motion was made by Wiese, seconded by Greer, to give Ben Gerischer keys to the electric boxes at the shelters in City Park. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Greer, seconded by Wiese, to have the Mayor pick up candy for the 4th of July parade. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Greer, seconded by Hammons to table the stormwater utility and spill prevention program. All ayes. Carried.

Motion by Hammons, seconded by Greer, to extend the meeting to 9:30 p.m. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Hammons, seconded by Greer, to approve the Heartland Security bid for a different alarm system at the wastewater treatment plant for \$240.00 installation and a monthly fee of \$19.00. All ayes. Carried.

Motion was made by Wiese and Hammons for discussion of Tom Zubers raise. Motion made by Wiese and Hammons to give him a \$3.05 an hour increase and the same yearly raises that the employees receive. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Hammons and Wiese to approve the cigarette license renewals. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Wiese and Greer to approve Clarks Landing beer license renewal. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Carson and Greer to extend the meeting to 9:45 p.m.

Motion made by Hammons and Greer to table the spending of option tax money for the balance of the storm warning sirens that the riverboat grant did not cover. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Greer, seconded by Carson, to table the second reading of Ordinance #398, "Parking Regulations". All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Hammons, seconded by Greer, to approve the second reading of Ordinance #399, "Meeting Dates..." Voting yes were Carson, Wiese, Hammons, Greer. Absent, Stowe. Carried. Motion made by Greer and Hammons to waive the third reading and adopt Ordinance #399. Voting yes were Greer, Wiese, Carson, Hammons. Absent, Stowe. Carried.

Motion was made by Greer, seconded by Hammons, to approve the second reading of Ordinance #400, "Jake Brakes..." Voting yes were Greer, Hammons, Carson, Wiese. Absent, Stowe. Carried.

Motion made by Greer, seconded by Wiese, to approve Resolution #11-2005, "Lien On Property Taxes For 903 Franklin Street". Voting yes were Wiese, Carson, Hammons, Greer. Absent, Stowe. Carried.


Motion by Carson, seconded by Hammons, to extend the meeting to 10:00 p.m.

Motion by Hammons, seconded by Carson, to put copies of billing slips and date of computer training in council mailboxes. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Hammons that the minutes be put in their mailboxes within 5 days. Discussion. Motion made by Hammons to change it to 7 days to have the minutes in their mailboxes. Discussion. Greer made a motion for 7 days. Hammons made a motion to do her best to have them in there in 7 days. Greer seconded that. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Carson, seconded by Wiese, to extend the meeting to 10:10 p.m. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Hammons, seconded by Greer, to adjourn the meeting at approximately 10:20 p.m. All ayes. Carried.
