Motion made by Stowe and Carson to approve the first reading of Ordinance #401, "AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING ALCOHOL BEVERAGE SALES, FOURTH OF JULY". All voted yes on a roll call vote. Carried.


Motion made by Stowe and Wiese to approve the renewal beer license for Express Lane Gas & Food Store. All voted aye. Carried.


Motion made by Stowe and Carson for discussion of allowing owners of cemetery lots in the older section of the cemetery to exchange them for lots in the new section of the cemetery, with accompanying original deeds to turn in to City Hall. All ayes. Carried.

Motion made by Hammons and Stowe for discussion of allowing cremains to be buried with/inside of present burials. All ayes. Carried. This will be worked out on individual cases.

Motion was made by Stowe and Greer to discuss the requested \$5.00 per hour raise for Tom Zuber, Building Inspector/Zoning Enforcement Officer/Rental Inspector. Motion made by Greer, seconded by Carson, to give him the requested \$5.00 per hour increase. Voting yes were Greer, Carson, Stowe and Wiese. Voting no, Hammons. Carried.

Motion made by Greer, seconded by Stowe, to adjourn the meeting at 8:11 p.m. All voted aye. Carried.
