

Minutes of the Buffalo Ordinance Committee meeting held on June 13, 2007.

Meeting called to order by Chairperson Gina Guizar at 6 pm. Present were committee member Mitch Greer, Councilmember Judy Hammons, and City Clerk Bill Bowers.

Street Lights

Bowers stated that DPW has not yet prepared a list of street lights so this cannot be discussed this evening. He explained that the city has an ordinance that requires payment to the electric utility for any private street lights. Currently no resident or business is charged for a private light. DPW will inventory the lights and let the committee know how many private lights there are.

Truck Parking on Front Street

The committee reviewed Ordinance 398 which was created in 2005 and never adopted. The ordinance did not allow any truck, van, or semi-truck to park along the north side of Front Street, from Washington Street to Jefferson Street. A resident has asked that this be reviewed.

Motion by Greer to recommend to Council adoption of an ordinance stating that there will be no parking of Semi Tractors, Semi Trailers, or Recreational Vehicles along the north side of Front Street from Clark Street to Franklin Street. Seconded by Guizar and carried unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by Greer at 6:15 pm. Seconded by Guizar and carried unanimously.
