

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Buffalo City Council, Iowa held on February 4, 2008.

Hammons resigned from the Neighborhood Watch Committee and Smith will replace her. No action on the signs.

BAC Parking Bids

Motion by Smith to approve the quote from Hawkeye Paving for the BAC Parking in an amount of \$21,570 and to request a change order to deal with the drainage problems in front of the building. The City has received a grant of \$15,000 to help pay for this project. Seconded by Guizar and carried unanimously.

Soda Machine in Park

Motion by Smith to contract with a local vendor for placement of a soda machine to be placed under the front pavilion at City Park. Seconded by Greer and carried unanimously.

Substation Fence

Bollman was directed to repair the fence at the substation.

Appreciation Dinner

Council decided on March 22 for the annual dinner and staff was directed to make all necessary plans.

Ordinances



Tabled Items - None


Future Meetings
