

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Buffalo City Council, Iowa held on March 3, 2008.

Meeting called to order by Mayor John Carson at 7:05 pm. Present were Councilmembers Gina Guizar, Christine Carson, Mitch Greer, Judy Hammons, and Dana Jo Smith. Also present were Director of Public Works Dwain Bollman, Police Chief Gage Adams, Assistant City Engineer Brian Parks and City Clerk Bill Bowers.

Those present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes

Motion by C. Carson to approve the minutes of February 4 and 11, 2008. Seconded by Greer and carried unanimously.

Claims

Motion by C. Carson to approve the claims as presented. Seconded by Greer and carried unanimously.

Public Input

The fire at Helen Johnsons home and a request that all men grow a beard for Buffalo Day were discussed.

Department and Committee Reports

Sheila Downs provided a Community Center update.

There was no Park Board Update

Bollman provided a DPW update.

Chief Adams provided a Police update.

Planning and Zoning Commission – Oak Valley Addition

Motion by Greer to accept the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of no objection to the plat and to waive the right of review. Seconded by Hammons and carried unanimously.

Easter Egg Hunt Donation

Motion by Greer to approve the donation for the Easter Egg Hunt in an amount of \$500. Seconded by C. Carson and carried unanimously.

Scott County 2008 Pavement Program

Motion by Greer to approve the 2008 pavement program with the understanding that Y-40 will not be painted until the road has been resurfaced. Seconded by Hammons and carried unanimously.

West End Curb and Gutter

Motion by C. Carson to accept the bid from All-American Concrete for the West End Curb and Gutter project for Scope 1 with Alternative 1 in an amount of \$302,151.99, to be paid by Road Tax Funds. Seconded by Greer and carried unanimously.

2008-09 Budget

Motion by C. Carson to accept the FY 08-09 budget as presented. Seconded by Hammons and carried unanimously.

BAC Door Project

Motion by C. Carson to accept the bid from American Industrial Door for the replacement of the door and frame by the Library/Gen Age entrance and installation of handicap openers at the Library and Main entrances at the BAC in an amount of \$7,523.79, \$6,000 to be paid via a grant from the Riverboats. Seconded by Hammons and carried unanimously.

Resolutions

Motion by Greer to approve Resolution 2008-02 “A Resolution to Waive the Right to Review Oak Valley Addition”. Seconded by C. Carson and carried unanimously.

Ordinances

Motion by C. Carson to accept the 3rd reading and adoption of Ordinance 420 “An Ordinance amending Title III, Chapter 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Buffalo relating to Animal Protection and Control”. Seconded by Hammons. Mayor called for a roll call vote ~ Smith – yes, Hammons – yes, Greer – no, Carson – yes, Guizar – yes. Motion carried.


Future Meetings

The Neighborhood Watch committee will meet April 2nd at 6 pm.


Public Input
